REGISTRATION DATES

Priority is given to students, staff, and faculty who currently have children enrolled in the program. Parents who have submitted a registration application will be considered after the following dates:

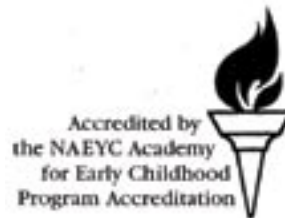
Fall Semester April 1
Spring Semester December 1

Any child who cannot be enrolled for the desired semester will be put on a waiting list. The Director will periodically contact people on the waiting list to inform them of their status.

ABOUT CAMPUS KIDS

Campus Kids is accredited by the National Association for the Education of Young Children (NAEYC). Our mission is to provide a safe and nurturing environment for children of students, faculty and staff at Miami University Hamilton, while promoting and enhancing the development of the children we serve.

ELIGIBILITY

Campus Kids is open to children whose parents are staff, faculty or students of the Miami University Hamilton campus. One parent or legal guardian must be enrolled for a minimum of six (6) credit hours per semester with at least three (3) credit hours at the Hamilton campus. Staff or faculty must be employed at least half time on the Hamilton Campus.



CLASSROOMS & STAFFING

The center has two classrooms: a toddler classroom serving ages 18 months to 36 months, and a preschool classroom serving 3 years to 6 years old. Maximum group size is 12 for the toddler program and 17 for the preschool program. The child/staff ratio exceeds the requirements of the State of Ohio:

Age Group	State of Ohio	Campus Kids
Toddlers	1:7	1:4
Preschoolers	1:10	1:7

HOURS

The center is open late August until early May. Hours are 7:30am to 5:30pm, Monday through Friday or until the last child is scheduled. There is no child care during the summer months or semester breaks.

FEES

Current fees are posted on the web site. Fees are based on number of scheduled hours per week, number of children enrolled by a parent, and whether the parent is faculty/staff or a student. Fees are subject to change; registration fee is due when then parent accepts the childcare slot.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

A limited number of childcare scholarships are funded by the Childcare Access Means Parents in School (CCAMPIS) grant sponsored by the Department of Education. The scholarships provide a reduction in fees. Childcare financial assistance is also available from Ohio Jobs & Family Services. Call **785.3011** for more information.
