## HAMILTON SCHOLARSHIPS

Scholarships vary greatly, according to the wishes of the donors making the funds available. Some may have additional requirements applicable to only certain students. Please check the box beside each of the following scholarships for which you wish to receive consideration. For continuing full or part time Miami students, contact the academic department of your major to see if there are additional applications for your major.

Note: The criteria for these awards vary greatly and may include, but are not limited to: merit, financial need, field of study, age, ethnic background, extracurricular involvement, etc. The scholarship committee will use the information provided on this application to match you with the appropriate scholarship for which you may qualify.

Harry T. Wilks Scholarship: This scholarship is available for new students only who are entering college directly from high school. This scholarship is based on merit and need, and is intended "for those who could not otherwise afford to go to college." This renewable scholarship pays for all tuition, fees and books, less any other gift-aid received, up to a student's total need.

Hamilton Campus Scholar Leader Program: The Nancy Sohngen Cottrell Scholar Leader Award, the Karen S. House Scholar Leader Award, and the Richard Fitton Scholar Leader Award are for current students who demonstrate active leadership at the University and in the community.

Tech Prep Scholarship: If you graduated from a high school Tech Prep program with at least a 2.5 high school GPA and are pursuing a university technical program, you may receive a Tech Prep freshman scholarship.

Hamilton Campus Community Award: This award is need and merit-based, so a FAFSA must be filed for consideration. This has a preference to under-represented groups on campus.
