- Reflect self-consciously on one's own values, learning process or work
- Collaborate with other learners productively and purposefully
- Demonstrate responsible citizenship by putting knowledge into practice for the betterment of society and community

MISSION & LEARNING OUTCOMES

Emphasizing scholarship, leadership and service, the Hamilton Honors Program of Miami University fosters a learning environment that enhances students' and faculty's intellectual and personal growth and sense of civic responsibility in a multicultural world.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- First semester entering students participating in the Hamilton Honors Program will typically have graduated in the top 10% of their high school class and/or have earned high scores on the SAT or on the ACT
- Second semester freshmen, sophomores, juniors, and seniors may enroll in the Hamilton Honors Program if they have taken at least 15 credit hours and earned a GPA of 3.5 or higher
- First semester transfer students are considered for participation on a case-by-case basis
- In order to continue in the Hamilton Honors Program students must maintain a minimum 3.2 GPA or better during their first and second year
- All Honors courses must be passed with a 'B' or better
