

**IN-STATE TUITION ELIGIBILITY FOR
RESIDENTS OF THESE INDIANA COUNTIES**

Miami University Hamilton and Miami University Middletown are part of a tuition reciprocity agreement between the Ohio Board of Regents and the Indiana Commission on Higher Education.

Under the terms of this agreement, Indiana residents of the counties specified above may enroll at Miami University Hamilton or Miami University Middletown and pay in-state fees as though they were Ohio residents.

A student must satisfy all regular admission requirements (including those requirements of the specific course or program in which admission is sought), and complete and submit an application form for tuition reciprocity prior to enrolling for classes.

Failure to apply in advance of enrollment will constitute a waiver of all rights for that semester of enrollment and any preceding semester of enrollment for which no application was made.

Students will be eligible for Ohio resident tuition status only for those courses offered by Miami University Hamilton or Miami University Middletown on either of the regional campuses, or at locations where courses or programs are offered by the regional campuses. Tuition reciprocity status is limited to Miami University Hamilton and Miami University Middletown and the student's status as a regional campus student.

Tuition reciprocity is not available at Miami University Oxford or for Oxford courses. Should a student relocate to the Oxford campus or take an Oxford course (in Oxford or at an off-site location), eligibility for Ohio resident tuition status shall cease and the student will revert to non-resident status.

Student enrollment status will be reviewed each term and the campus of the student shall be determined in accordance with existing Miami University policies and procedures.

The amount of financial aid a student is eligible to receive may be reduced as a result of electing to participate in the reciprocity program due to the change from non-resident to Ohio resident status.

Once enrolled as a reciprocity student, a student must demonstrate satisfactory academic performance. The student will continue to receive reciprocity benefits under the agreement through graduation for the degree in which enrolled as long as a reciprocity agreement exists. Student participation is subject to the terms and conditions of the institutional reciprocity agreement in effect at the time of initial enrollment.

In the event of the termination of the tuition reciprocity agreement, each participating student will be informed of his/her future status. If the agreement is terminated, Miami University Hamilton and Miami University Middletown may, but are not required to, continue tuition reciprocity for the students appropriately enrolled in eligible courses or programs at the time of termination until the completion of their programs of study.

Miami University reserves the right to require proof of county residence.
