November 1, 2007

The meeting was called to order at 8:01 A.M. by Tyler. In attendance at the meeting: Tyler, Katie, Chrisy, Jason, Lynnette, Anna, Bailey, Cameron, Brandon, Chris, Gina, Dr. Bob, and Dr. Dave. Matthew was absent from the meeting. Katie moved to excuse Matthew from the meeting; Brandon seconded the motion; motion passed with a vote of six ayes, two nays, and zero abstentions. Anna explained that she missed the October 25th meeting due to car trouble. Chrisy moved to excuse Anna from the October 25th meeting; Bailey seconded the motion; motion passed with a vote of seven ayes, one nay, and zero abstentions.

Katie had no new business to report.

Jason informed the group that there had been no new transactions on the budget.

Chrisy informed the group that the minutes for the last meeting would be available next week.

Chrisy reported to the group the meeting with Student Concerns Committee (SCC). She stated that there was discussion concerning the business that the committee will handle and safety in the crosswalks on campus. Katie informed the group that the Search Committee for Hamilton Downtown had decided that there was not a viable candidate and the search would continue.

Tyler informed the group that the presentation from the EDL 306 would be postponed until next week.

The group filled out an Internal Group Assessment that was put together by Tyler. Tyler will calculate the results and present them to the group next week.

Tyler distributed a copy of an e-mail from Annie Miller that discussed the possibility of the group working together with Wilks High School Engagement Program to participate in a leadership conference. Members volunteered their time to help out.

Tyler will be meeting with the president of the ASG to discuss the various issues.

Tyler and Katie discussed the iLead session they attended. They encouraged other members to attend.

Tyler discussed the Red Kettle Campaign hours of operation. He explained to the group that it would be easier if members were at the kettles at the start of the kettles at 10 A.M. or stay until the close of the kettles at 8 P.M.

It was agreed that there needs to be a Director of Marketing by the beginning of next semester. It was decided that the group needed to contact Annie Miller for help in filling the position.

Tyler spoke to Matthew about a conversation Matthew had with his mother Kathy Becker, Vice Major of Hamilton concerning the crosswalk issue. Matthew told Tyler that Kathy would make an appeal to see if she could get the safety of the crosswalk improved. Dr. Bob informed the group that Major Ryan said that the request for lights was a reasonable request. Dr. Bob suggested that he, Matthew, and Tyler have a meeting with Dr. Hall. There will be further discussion at a later meeting.

Tyler agreed to get the contract from Ratona Harr for the Colligate Readership Program.

The group agreed to collect ten items for the United Way Silent Auction. Collected donations are expected at the next meeting so that Matthew can deliver them to Annie.

Dr. Bob informed the group that the Y-Care event attended by he, Tyler, Chrisy, and Anna raised more than \$100,000.

Chrisy moved to adjourn the meeting; Katie seconded the motion; motion passed unanimously.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:05 A.M. by Tyler.
