May 30, 2007

The meeting was called to order at 5:32 P.M. by Tyler.

Tyler distributed a handout that outlined his meeting with Jim Neidhard concerning the fundraising for the CPI. Mr. Neidhard had made several suggestions to improve the plead sheet. The group agreed that the CPI is expanding in a whole new direction. The CPI is considering adopting the Artist Series and Michael J. Colligan Lecture Series. The group agreed that adding the Artist Series and Michael J. Colligan Lecture Series that it will increase the awareness of the events on the campus. There will be a section on the SGA website for the CPI. Chrisy moved to except Bailey and Fatma as co-chairs of the CPI; Cameron seconded the motion; motion passed unanimously. Chrisy accepted the expanded vision for the CPI; Katie seconded the motion: motion passed unanimously.
