The group discussed changing the display board in Mosler. It was decided that the group would use magazine covers as the new theme.

Tyler updated the group on the FIAT meeting.

The Director of Marketing search committee will continue to search for a qualified candidate to fill the position.

Brandon moved to adjourn the meeting; Matthew seconded the motion; motion passed unanimously.

Tyler adjourned the meeting at 6:28 P.M.
