Time Allotment: 50 Minutes

Grade Level(s): 8th Grade

Subject Matter: Punishment in slavery

SWBAT to identify forms of punishment/torture methods of slaves and explain reasons behind them by viewing pictures

Prep for Teachers:

Research, photocopy overheads, and handouts

Introductory Activity: (remember to number each step)

1. Pictures on overhead as students enter the room
2. In notebooks, the students will answer:
"what are these pictures representing and why is this happening?"

Materials: Pictures, overhead, blackboard, notebooks, pencils, pen

Learning Activities: (remember to number each step)

1. All students receive copies of pictures with text explaining pictures
2. Read together as a class
3. Classroom floor open for discussion
4. ask: "reactions," "thoughts, " & "questions?"

Materials: Copies of pictures and related texts

Culminating Activity: (remember to number each step)

1. Homework: read slavery section of textbook
2. Answer section review questions
3. Give overview of tomorrow's lesson which will take place in computer labs where the students will research slavery more in depth

Materials: Textbooks, paper, pen or pencil

Cross-Curricular Extensions:

English: researching/ reading primary slavery more in depth (pictures & narrative)
Psych. : Impact of punishment on groups as a whole

Community Connections:

Use Ohio River in connection with the Underground Railroad

Student Material:

Textbooks, Notebooks, writing utensils

Assessment:

Participation, Journal entries, questions, and chapter test.
